

**CITY OF SAN MATEO
ORDINANCE NO. 2013-10**

AMENDING SECTION 1.04.050 “ENFORCEMENT-CITATION AUTHORITY”

WHEREAS, the City adopted an oversized vehicle parking restriction ordinance in May 2013 by amending Chapters 11 and 17 of the San Mateo Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that San Mateo Police Department’s Community Service Officers and Parking Enforcement Representatives will assist in enforcing the oversized vehicle parking restriction ordinance by issuing administrative citations; and

WHEREAS, Section 1.04.050 of the San Mateo Municipal Code lists administrative citation authority for specific code sections by job title which currently only authorizes Community Service Officers and Parking Enforcement Representatives to issue administrative citations for violations of Title 11 of the San Mateo Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to authorize Community Service Officers and Parking Enforcement Representatives to also issue administrative citations for violations of Title 17;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, ORDAINS as follows:

Section 1. Section 1.040.050(a), in Chapter 1.04, is amended to add “Title 17” to the Code Sections for which Community Service Officers and Parking Enforcement Representatives are authorized to issue administrative citations.

Section 2. The remainder of Section 1.04.050 is unchanged.

Section 3. CEQA. This project is exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requirements in that it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment per CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3).

Section 4. SEVERABILITY. In the event any section, clause or provision of this Chapter shall be determined invalid or unconstitutional, such section, clause or provision shall be deemed severable and all other sections or portions hereof shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. PUBLICATION. This Ordinance shall be published in summary in the San Francisco Examiner Peninsula Edition, posted in the City Clerk’s Office, and posted on the City’s website, all in accord with Section 2.15 of the Charter and shall be effective 30 days after the date of adoption.
